- Visit philippineairlines.com and click 'Manage Booking' in the top menu.
- Enter your booking reference (PNR) and last name, then click Retrieve Booking.
- Select the flight segment for which you want to pick a seat.
- Click 'Change Seat' or 'Add Seat Selection' to open the interactive aircraft map.
- Choose your seat, review the fee (if applicable), and confirm.
- An updated e-ticket will be sent to your registered email address.

Seat selection through Manage Booking is available until online check-in closes (typically 1 hour before departure for domestic and 2 hours before for international flights). If you need help with your PNR or cannot access your booking, call **+1(888)483-9719**.

Using the PAL Mobile App to Select Your Seat

The Philippine Airlines mobile app, available for free on both iOS (App Store) and Android (Google Play), provides a full-featured booking and trip management experience. After downloading and opening the app, tap 'My Trips', retrieve your booking using your PNR and last name, and select the flight you wish to modify. Tap 'Seat Selection' to view the aircraft map and choose your preferred seat. The app also sends real-time notifications about check-in windows, gate assignments, and schedule changes, making it the most convenient tool for managing how to select seat on Philippine Airlines from anywhere in the world.

Seat Selection at Check-In: Online and at the Airport

Philippine Airlines opens online check-in 24 hours before departure for most international flights and domestic routes. This is another opportunity to learn how to select seat on Philippine Airlines if you have not done so already. During web check-in, the system will display remaining available seats, some of which may be offered at a reduced price or even at no charge if the flight has low occupancy. For passengers who prefer in-person check-in, airport counters open approximately 3 hours before international departures and 2 hours before domestic ones. At the counter, a PAL check-in agent can assign seats based on availability. Premium locations such as exit rows and bulkhead seats may still carry a fee at this stage. Always carry your booking reference or e-ticket when visiting the airport counter. If you need to pre-arrange airport check-in seating for a large group, contact **+1(888)483-9719** at least 48 hours in advance.

Fare Classes and Complimentary Seat Selection

Philippine Airlines operates a tiered fare structure. Whether seat selection is free or paid depends on the fare type purchased:

Economy Saver: Seat selection is not included. A complimentary random seat is assigned at check-in. Paid seat upgrades are available as an add-on.

Economy Value: Standard seat selection is included at no extra charge. Exit rows and bulkhead seats carry an additional fee.

Economy Flex: Standard seat selection is included. Greater flexibility to change seats without incurring new fees.

Premium Economy: Seat selection within the Premium Economy cabin is fully included. Upgrading to a specific row may cost a nominal fee.

Mabuhay Class (Business): All seat selections within the Business Class cabin are complimentary. Passengers can choose any available lie-flat pod prior to departure.

First Class: All First Class suite selections are fully complimentary, with assistance from a dedicated PAL concierge team.

Mabuhay Miles Members: Priority Seat Access

Philippine Airlines' frequent flyer programme, Mabuhay Miles, offers significant benefits when it comes to seat selection. Elite tier members — Gold, Platinum, and Million Miler — enjoy complimentary advance seat selection across all fare types, including Economy Saver. Even standard Mabuhay Miles members receive earlier access to preferred seats compared to non-members. If you are a frequent traveller with PAL, enrolment in Mabuhay Miles is free and can immediately improve your seating experience. Log in with your Mabuhay Miles number during the booking process or in the Manage Booking portal to unlock your tier benefits. Expert Tips to Get the Best Seat on Philippine Airlines

- **Book Early and Select Immediately:** The window seats and exit row aisle seats fill up fastest. Book and select your seat at least 4 to 8 weeks before departure for domestic routes and 8 to 12 weeks for international flights.
- **Study the Seat Map First:** Before paying for any seat, review the full seat map on SeatGuru or the PAL website to understand the layout, proximity to lavatories, galley noise, and bassinet locations.
- **Choose a Higher Fare Tier:** On long-haul routes, upgrading from Economy Saver to Economy Value or Flex often includes seat selection and is frequently more economical than paying for each ancillary separately.
- **Enrol in Mabuhay Miles:** Even as a basic member, you get priority over non-members in seat selection queues.
- **Select Bulkhead for Families with Infants:** Bulkhead rows accommodate bassinet attachments for infants under 12 months. Request this seat category by calling **+1(888)483-9719** as it is not always selectable online.

- **Monitor Price Changes:** Seat fees fluctuate with demand. Checking back 1–2 weeks before departure sometimes reveals lower pricing on previously expensive seats.
- **Use Preferred Check-In Windows:** Open web check-in exactly 24 hours before departure to access the widest range of remaining free seats.
- **Avoid the Last Few Rows:** On most PAL narrow-body aircraft, the last 3–4 rows have non-reclining seats due to proximity to the rear bulkhead.

Seat Selection for Special Travellers

Passengers with Disabilities or Reduced Mobility

Philippine Airlines is committed to accessible travel in compliance with the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) and IATA accessibility standards. Passengers requiring wheelchair assistance, stretcher service, or specialised seating must contact PAL's Special Assistance desk. These seats — typically bulkhead aisle positions — are not available through standard online seat maps and must be arranged by telephone. Call **+1(888)483-9719** at least 48 hours before departure to make accessibility seat arrangements at no additional charge.

Travelling with Infants and Young Children

For passengers travelling with infants who require bassinet (sky cot) service, PAL assigns bulkhead seats on long-haul wide-body aircraft (A330, A350, B777). These seats are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis by the PAL reservations team. Since bassinets cannot be booked through the online seat map, calling **+1(888)483-9719** immediately after booking is strongly recommended. Children aged 2–11 travelling with an adult are subject to PAL's unaccompanied minor policy; the airline will ensure seating adjacent to the accompanying adult on the same booking.

Unaccompanied Minors (UM)

PAL's Unaccompanied Minor programme applies to children aged 5–11 travelling alone on domestic flights and 8–11 on international routes. For UM passengers, seating is pre-arranged by PAL staff — typically in middle-of-cabin aisle seats for visibility — and cannot be self-selected. All UM bookings must be made by phone. Contact **+1(888)483-9719** to initiate a UM booking and confirm seating arrangements.

Group Bookings (10+ Passengers)

For groups of 10 or more passengers, Philippine Airlines offers dedicated group booking rates and block seat arrangements through its Group Sales department. Online self-service does not support block seating for groups. To secure adjacent seats for a tour, corporate delegation, or family reunion flight, call **+1(888)483-9719** and request the Group Sales desk for tailored seating and fare negotiation.

Preferred seat shows as unavailable: It may be held for frequent flyers or special needs passengers. Check back 72 hours before departure when holds are released.

Payment fails on seat selection: Ensure your card is enabled for international online transactions or try an alternative payment method.

Seat changed after aircraft substitution: PAL will rebook you in a comparable category. Call +1(888)483-9719 within 24 hours to request a specific seat on the new aircraft.

Duplicate seat charge on card statement: Contact PAL billing via +1(888)483-9719 with your booking reference. Duplicate charges are typically reversed within 5–7 business days.

Cannot find Manage Booking portal: Visit philippineairlines.com, click 'My Trips' or 'Manage Booking' in the top navigation bar and enter your PNR.

Q1. Is seat selection free on Philippine Airlines?

It depends on your fare type. Economy Value, Flex, Premium Economy, Mabuhay Class, and First Class all include complimentary standard seat selection. Economy Saver fare holders pay an additional fee unless assigned a free random seat at check-in. Mabuhay Miles elite members enjoy complimentary seat selection on all fare types. Call +1(888)483-9719 to verify what is included in your fare.

Q2. When does seat selection open on Philippine Airlines?

Seat selection opens at the time of booking and remains available up until online check-in closes (typically 24 hours before departure for international flights and 1 hour before for domestic). The earlier you select, the better your choices.

Q3. Can I change my seat after selecting it?

Yes. You can change your seat via Manage Booking or the PAL mobile app at any time before check-in closes. If you wish to upgrade from a standard seat to an exit row or bulkhead seat, additional fees may apply. Post-check-in changes must be handled at the airport check-in counter. Q4. What happens if I do not select a seat on Philippine Airlines?

A complimentary random seat will be assigned during check-in. While PAL attempts to seat families together, there is no guarantee of window or aisle placement. For any

specific preference — particularly on long-haul flights — it is strongly advisable to proactively complete seat selection in advance.

Q5. Can I select an exit row seat on Philippine Airlines?

Yes, but passengers in exit rows must meet specific requirements: they must be at least 15 years old, physically capable of operating emergency exits, not pregnant, not travelling with an infant, and able to understand English safety instructions. Exit row seats are not available online for passengers who do not meet these criteria.

Q6. Does Philippine Airlines offer seat selection for codeshare flights?

Seat selection availability for codeshare flights depends on the operating carrier. If the flight is operated by a partner airline, you may need to visit that airline's website or call +1(888)483-9719 to arrange seating. Confirm the operating carrier on your booking confirmation.

Q7. How do I get a bulkhead seat with a bassinet on Philippine Airlines?

Bulkhead seats with bassinet attachment points are not selectable online. They must be requested by calling +1(888)483-9719 at least 48 hours before departure. Bassinets are available for infants under 12 months and under the maximum weight specified by PAL (typically 11–13 kg).

Q8. Can I select seats for all passengers in my booking at once?

Yes. When using the online seat map during booking or via Manage Booking, the interface allows you to select seats for each passenger listed in your reservation sequentially. For group bookings of 10 or more, call +1(888)483-9719 for block seating assistance.

Q9. Is the seat selection fee refundable if I cancel my Philippine Airlines booking?

Seat selection fees are generally non-refundable. However, if PAL cancels or significantly reschedules your flight, you may be entitled to a full refund including seat fees. For Economy Flex fare holders, more lenient refund conditions may apply. Call +1(888)483-9719 to review your specific refund entitlement.

Q10. How do I select a seat on Philippine Airlines as a Mabuhay Miles member?

During booking or in Manage Booking, enter your Mabuhay Miles membership number. Depending on your tier (Blue, Silver, Gold, Platinum, or Million Miler), complimentary seat selection will be applied automatically. Elite members (Gold and above) can select seats even on Economy Saver fares without extra charge. Contact +1(888)483-9719 for tier-related seating questions.
